Manny. (Stands. Flexes his knees.) Mine seem to be working fine.

Manny. Sorry Sarah. Now that I think about it, I may have heard you say AOL but in my head I went right to ACL.

Manny. I don't like guns.

Sarah. DNA Manny. DNA. Not NRA.
